



Zoom Engagement Guidelines

Due to Covid-19 TCBC Youth And Kids will now be regularly meeting on Zoom. As you join us, for the safety of all the young people, and the safety of the leadership team, we require you to observe the following guidelines:

Participants can only attend Youth/Blast Online if they have submitted a permission form found at: <https://bit.ly/TCBCOnline>

Unfortunately, without a permission note you won't be allowed to log in.

Participants are not to record the TCBC Youth/Blast Meeting. Leaders will turn this function off where possible. Where there is only one leader present, we are required to record the meeting and store the recording.

Participants must wear appropriate attire while on Zoom. We ask that participants wear appropriate attire just as they would if attending TCBC Youth/Blast on site. This means no revealing or inappropriate clothing.

Participants must not share any inappropriate text, images, backgrounds or any other content in the live feed, chat function, or by any other means.

Participants must not engage in any inappropriate conversations. Any content that could be considered by the leaders to be pornographic, bullying, derogatory, defamatory or in any way inappropriate will not be tolerated. This includes what participants say both verbally and using the private chat function.
