### **Some Hints**

- All food to be within use by or best before date.
- All food must be unopened, sealed.
- All items must not be damaged.
- Home cooked food is not accepted (sorry) including jams, preserves, chutneys, baked goods etc
- Fresh meat items (fish, chicken, lamb, beef etc) are not accepted. Tinned salmon, tuna, etc are ok.

#### **How Does It Work?**

- 1. Grab some shopping bags, take this list and head to the supermarket.
- 2. Make your purchases.

## A suggestion for families

- Talk with the children about why you are doing this shopping and what will happen to it.
- Individual kids might choose the items they would like to buy.
- Head to the supermarket as a family. The children head off to find the items they chose.
- 3. When coming to church, bring your shopping bag and place it at the front of the church.
- 4. Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> November will be the last day for collection
